

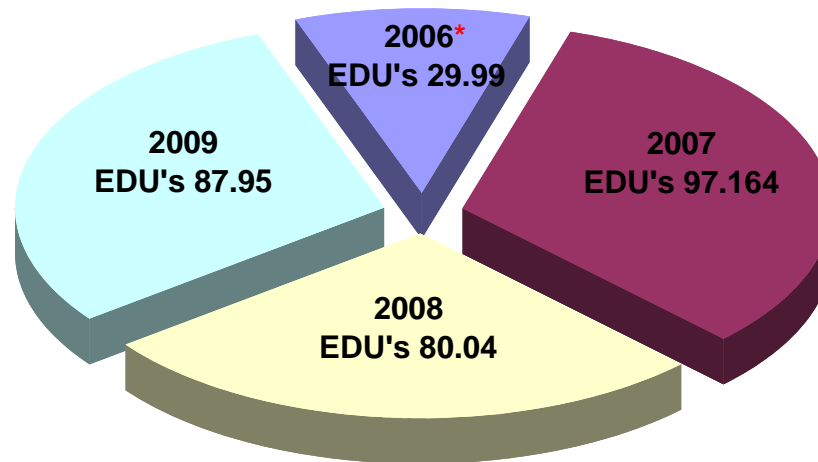


**Minden Gardnerville Sanitation District  
District Manager's Report  
January 2010**

1. EDU allocations: 13.85 EDU's were allocated during the month of December. Despite the recent downturn in construction and other projects, the EDU allocations over the last 4 years have remained consistent. (See attached sheet).
2. Legal: At the November meeting the board directed me to meet with MGSD legal counsel to discuss the EDU calculations for multiple drain sinks. Bill Peterson will be in attendance at the meeting to discuss and offer his recommendations. In addition, he is expected to discuss the appropriation of funds in the odor control account, as recommended by Richard Peters.
3. Grease Receiving/Co-Generation Project: The mandatory pre-bid conference was held on December 29<sup>th</sup> with 5 potential contractors to bid upon the project. The bids are to be opened on January 15<sup>th</sup>, with the Board expected to award the bid at the February 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting.
4. Bio-Solids Disposal: Bently has agreed to start accepting our bio-solids by mid January. While a contract still needs to be ratified, it was, with approval of MGSD legal counsel, verbally agreed that MGSD will be able to deliver bio-solids to Bently's facilities with the contract pending. I am still awaiting confirmation on the agreement from Bently.
